- Delegates responsibilities to others
- Successfully holds school offices or positions of responsibility; conducts business effectively and efficiently; demonstrates reliability and dependability

Character

- Consistently exemplifies desirable qualities of behavior (i.e. cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, stability)
- Upholds principles of morality and ethics
- Complies with school regulations concerning uniform, property, programs, office, and so on

- Regularly shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others
- Observes instructions and rules, and is punctual and faithful both inside and outside of the classroom
